

Cooperative Cosmetology Tuition & Fees

Capri Beauty College maintains a Training Agreement between Lincoln-Way High School District 210 and Lockport Township High School District 205 through which an accredited institution provides training to students.

Cosmetology is a clock hour program. Illinois requires 1500 hours of training. The first 600 hours are earned while in high school. The remaining 900 hours are earned after high school completion. Once a student completes high school, s/he becomes eligible to apply for Federal Grants and Loans which may be used to pay for 900 hour tuition charges.
